The pandemic had stamped the need for businesses to digitalise and automate in order to remain viable. Arming oneself with new skill sets revolving around digitalisation became a necessity which the human resources sector had to embrace quickly, according to founder of Kakitangan.com Effon Khoo.

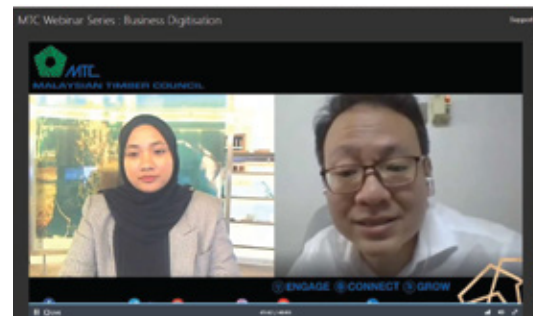
In a webinar organised by MTC today, Khoo said from bulk online payments

involving salaries, statutory forms, leave applications or expenses claims, data needed to be managed virtually over a secure system.

In his presentation titled “Create Better Talent Organisation and Automate People Operations – A Glance at HR/Payroll Cloud and SME Digitalisation Grant”, Khoo said HR must “automate” its operations and be apt in reviewing its organisation structure, talent pool and incentive plans, among others, online.

Participants during the session obtained insights about data cloud storage, KPI relevance, and the benefits of automation.

At the same time, participants also were advised to identify their business bottleneck, and then work on people’s operation. Continuous improvement is the key for business success.
