## **Malaysian Timber Council Appoints New CEO**

18 December 2015, Kuala Lumpur - Datuk Dr Abdul Rahim Haji Nik, the former Deputy Secretary General (Environment) of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment, has been appointed Chief Executive Officer of the Malaysian Timber Council (MTC). He succeeded Datuk M Nagarajan, the former Interim CEO who is also the Deputy Secretary General of the Ministry of Plantation Industries and Commodities, effective 16 November 2015.

In his new role, Datuk Dr Abdul Rahim will continue to spearhead MTC's efforts in promoting the growth of the Malaysian timber trade and industry, and develop the market for Malaysian timber and furniture products globally.

He was also involved in the organization and operations of various national councils, including the Green Technology and Climate Change Council, the National Biodiversity Council, and the National Water Resources Council.

(IUFRO) based in Vienna (2010-2015)and WWF Malaysia Advisory Council. He is also an

Associate Fellow and Fellow of Academy Science Malaysia since 2012 and 2015, respectively.

Dr Abdul Rahim began his career as a research officer in Forest Research Institute Malaysia

(FRIM) in 1981 in-charge of the hydrology and watershed research. He completed his Ph. D.

degree in Forest Hydrology from the University of Wales, United Kingdom in 1990 and has a

bachelor degree in forestry and master degree from Louisiana State University (1979) and

University of West Virginia (1981), USA, respectively. He has published more than a hundred

technical and semi-technical papers in scientific journals and edited over 15 books.
